

COOPER MEDC – Current Position on RoHS

The European Union 'Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment' "RoHS" Directive (2011/65/EC), prohibits the sale of certain categories of electrical and electronic equipment containing certain hazardous substances such as lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls ("PBB") and polybrominated diphenylethers ("PBDE") in the European Union.

MEDC have established that our products are either not covered by, or are exempt from (fixed installations), the categories specified in the RoHS Directive.
