

EATON MEDC Ltd WEEE DIRECTIVE STATEMENT

The EC directive on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) became law in the UK on the 1st July 2007.

The Directive aims to minimise the impact of electrical and electronic goods on the environment, by increasing re-use and recycling and reducing the amount of WEEE going to landfill.

Eaton MEDC products produced since 13th August 2005 have been marked with a crossed out wheellie bin underlined with a thick black line –

Eaton MEDC has registered as a producer of Non Household WEEE through the Valpak Ltd compliance scheme.

As Eaton MEDC sells solely B2B, it discharges its own responsibilities under the Waste Electrical and Electronic (Producer Responsibility) Regulations 2006. That is, Eaton MEDC is responsible for the treatment, disposal and wherever possible recycling of all products produced since that date.

In compliance with the legislation, Eaton MEDC will also accept products back for disposal on a like for like basis any Historic WEEE of any manufacture (Products produced before 13th August 2005, identified by the lack of the thick black line under the crossed out wheellie bin).

This applies where new Eaton MEDC products have replaced the equivalent amount of historic WEEE products only. If any Historic WEEE is to be returned this must be advised prior to our acceptance of the order and a method and period agreed for the return of this waste.

To arrange disposal of any products under this scheme, the customer will need to contact our Customer Service Department (see contact us) and obtain a Goods Return (GR) number.

NOTE: If arranging to dispose of any WEEE without returning to Eaton MEDC, please ensure that WEEE is taken ONLY to an Approved Authorised Treatment Facility (AATF) for disposal.
