

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

Cookies allow us to understand who has seen which pages, and to determine the most popular areas of our web site. We also use cookies to store visitors' preferences, and to record session information, such as length of visit. Depending on the type of cookie we use, cookies also allow us to make our web site more user friendly, for example, permanent cookies allow us to save your password so that you do not have to re-enter it every time you visit our web site.

The cookies we use

The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

Cookie	Name	Purpose	More information
Google Analytics	_utma _utmb _utmc _utmz	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited.	http://www.google.com/policies/privacy/
Java Script	has_js	This cookie checks if a user has JavaScript enabled. This allows for site enhancements.	
SESS	SESS	A standard cookie used to identify user's browser. Most web servers use this cookie. 'SESS' cookie can have many characters appended to it.
